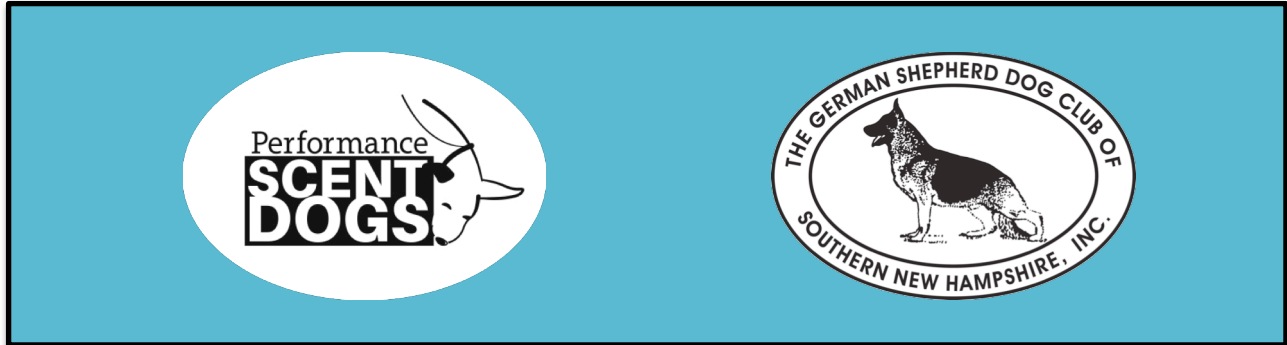

Entries are limited and accepted on a first received basis until classes fill.

Move-up date: May 13, 2018

Try Before Your Buy! Enter the trial without paying for dog registration. If you like how we do, register within 7 days after the trial to keep your results.

Pick and choose what classes are right for your dog

*Videotaping allowed*Earn legs toward titles*Competitor feedback encouraged *Watch and root for other competitors*Spend time with your dog in a welcoming atmosphere*

Turn any search at anytime into training by asking the judge the location of the hide

Come and have FUN with your dog!

Who can compete? Any and all dogs that are 10 months or older, on the day of the trial or the Target Odor Test (TOT), are eligible to compete.

What if I don't pass the TOT? You can still play!! Dogs must pass a Target Odor Test (TOT) in order to compete in the Standard Division, however if you do not pass you are still allowed to enter the trial as FEO (For Exhibition Only) for the day.

My dog has a Nose Work title from a different organization, do I have to pass a TOT? If you already have passed an odor test in another scent work organization you do not have to take the TOT. Dogs

with a NW3, SDDA Excellent or UKC Level 5 title may skip the Novice level and start PSD at the Advanced level. Please send a copy of your test results to PSD in order to register.

Can I watch other competitors? Yes you can watch, either after you run or you can watch a different level compete.

Can my friend videotape my searches? Yes! And you may post them anywhere you like.

Awards: Rosette ribbons will be awarded for standard 1st-3rd place in addition to Class Titles, and Level Titles. Ribbons will be awarded for Q's in all classes and Metallic Level 1st-3rd place. The GSDC-SNH will be giving away special awards to the fastest search completed by a GSD and the fastest completed by a non-GSD at each level.

Fees: Birch, Anise and Clove TOT - \$15.00; Novice classes - \$15.00; Advanced and Excellent - \$20.00.

Collars Any collar is allowed on the grounds except electronic or scent spraying collars. Only a flat, or martingale collar or leashes attached to a dead ring or harness are permitted to be used for searches. All dogs must be leashed at all times, except during an off-leash search. No tags are allowed on a collar during a search.

Crating YES, indoor crating is available!!!

Volunteers will help our Trial run smoothly. We need Timers, Gate Stewards, Score Runners, and Others. No Experience Required! **Volunteers Run FIRST in each class!**
Thanks in advance for your help.

Parking Parking in the lot is limited, but there is parking along the street which is very quiet. Please watch for cone or signs indicating an area is off limits for parking-it may be a search area. This trial will run by level (All Novice classes, then Advanced classes, and then Excellent classes).

Spectators are invited to come and watch a PSD trial.

Venue and Accessibility This building does have stairs that may lead to search areas and to the crating room. Some searches may be outside on pavement or rough ground. Please email the trial secretary for details.

Dogs In Need of Space The site has plenty of parking and places to walk dogs at a distance of 20 feet or more. There is a separate entrance and exit area. Volunteers will be onsite to help escort participants to and from the search area. A red bandana is encouraged, but please give all dogs space.

Handler running multiple dogs A handler *can* run multiple dogs in TOTs at any trial. At this trial, handlers may run one dog in any of the classes at any level. A second dog may run FEO. This could change depending on the number of competitors and will be determined the week of the trial.
